



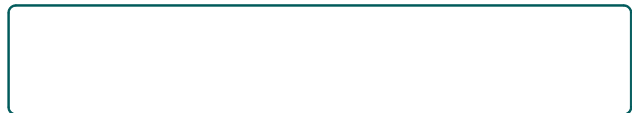
# Impact of schizophrenia on the Thai economy: a cross-sectional study

**Background:**
